

The Alabama State Port Authority (ASPA) has established an approved Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program in accordance with regulations of the U. S. Department of Transportation (DOT), 49 CFR Part 26. ASPA has received federal financial assistance from the Department of Transportation's Federal Transit Administration (FTA), and as a condition of receiving this assistance, ASPA has signed an assurance that it will comply with 49 CFR Part 26. This public notice is for FFY 2010 (October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010). ASPA is located in FTA's Region IV.

Goal:

We estimate that our FY 2010 overall goal of **16 %** will be obtained through Bids and Request for Qualifications/Request for Proposals. We propose that we will obtain 100 % from race-neutral measures and 0 % from race-conscious measures. In the event that The Alabama State Port Authority is unsuccessful in obtaining the goal through race-neutral means, we will implement race-conscious means to obtain the overall goal.

The Alabama State Port Authority will advertise for public comments from June 1, 2009 through June 30, 2009. We are available to receive public comments through July 15, 2009.
